Advance Reservations Required | No Walk Ups

Must be 21 years of age or older to reserve campsites or cabins.

Campsites

Limit 1 Camping Unit (RV, Tent, Camper)* and 2 Vehicles

Occupancy Limit - One Family (2 adults and up to 4 children 18 and under) | Maximum 4 adults

* Reservation of a Children's Tent can be added to a family's campsite reservation for their minor children

Cabins

No Pets. No Smoking. Limit 2 Vehicles

Occupancy Limit - 1 Family (2 adults and up to 3 children 18 and under) | Maximum 4 adults

To maintain a quiet, peaceful environment for all guests, all music, electronics, and conversations must be kept to a reasonable volume so as not to disturb other guests, as determined by the sole discretion of the camp staff. When away from your campsite or cabin, audio equipment shall be turned off. Generators may not be used at any time.

Excessive noise, drunkenness, foul language, immoral and illegal conduct are not permitted and will not be tolerated.

Smoking is prohibited in and around all camp buildings, shower houses and cabins.

Responsible use of alcohol, as determined by camp staff, is permitted at your campsite or cabin only. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the campground common areas, main camp, or at the waterfront.

Pets

- Pets must be leashed at all times and may not be left unattended.
- Pets are not allowed in the cabins, shower houses or any camp buildings, playground or waterfront.
- Owner is responsible to control dog's barking to ensure no disturbance to others and adherence to quiet hours.
- Owner is responsible for immediate clean-up of all their pet's droppings.
- Exotic or unusual animals are not allowed.
- Pets must be of good nature with strangers. Any incidents between a person and your pet, or your pet and another pet, must be reported to camp staff. Owners of the pet will be held responsible for any actions or charges from these incidents.

Clean Up / Cleaning Fee

- All trash must be bagged and placed in the dumpsters or taken with you.
- A \$50 per hour (\$50 minimum) charge will be applied for any excessive clean-up required, if the campsite or cabin is not left in the same condition as when you arrived. This includes cigarette butts, food scraps, water balloon remnants and trash left at the site.

Campfires are only allowed within the designated fire rings and must be fully extinguished if you leave the campsite and when you retire at night.

Firewood is offered for sale. Scavenging for firewood or cutting trees or underbrush is not permitted.

Nailing or screwing into trees is not permitted.

Picnic tables and fire rings may not be moved from a campsite, or tables or rings from other sites moved to your site

Fireworks, Firearms, Generators, ATVs, Off-Road Vehicles, Chainsaws, are not allowed in the campground

Shower Houses may not be used for cleaning dishes, clothing, or fish. No electrical appliances may be used in the shower facilities except for personal hygiene.

Portable toilets may not be dumped in the restroom. Use the dump station for that purpose.

No dumping gray water or waste water (including dishwater) on the ground. Use the dump station for disposal.

Speed limit 5 mph. If a vehicle leaves a dust trail, it is traveling too fast.

This property is privately owned. Campers accept privileges with the understanding that they hereby release Camp LuWiSoMo, its officers and employees, of all liability for loss or damage and agree to indemnify such against claims resulting from loss or damage to property or injury of themselves or their guests arising out of the use of the camp.

Non-compliance with these rules is considered grounds for immediate ejection from the campground without refund.
